Mary J. Klein was a dedicated board member on the Adolescent Parenting Coalition for many years. She devoted her time and talents to create opportunities for adolescent Mothers and their children in NE Wisconsin.

The Adolescent Parenting Coalition would like to recognize her contributions by funding scholarships in her honor:

- Scholarships up to \$1,000 each will be given annually to a recent graduate or graduating seniors from a high school or alternative high school program in Brown County who has overcome (or is overcoming) significant obstacles as a **parenting or pregnant teen**.
- The individual must demonstrate a desire to succeed in a post-secondary environment (college, technical or trade school). A low overall GPA would not disqualify a candidate since poor grades early in a high school career can be detrimental to a final GPA.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the educational institution the student is attending. No monies will go directly to the student
- Guidance counselors/school social workers/teachers/case managers/parent educators can nominate as many teen parents as they feel are qualified for the scholarship.

2. High school transcript
3. Field of study pursuing
4. ACT score, if taken
5. What work experience teen parent has, if any
